Learning Journals - Asking children to be involved in the assessment of their work, in reflecting on the process of learning including the parts they found tricky and what helped them grasp something new and by involving them in choosing examples that show progress and to make informed decisions on their next steps are important skills in becoming an independent learner. We are helping children develop these skills in an environment we call their Learning Journal. Each child has this private area in Knowledge Net for recording reflections about their learning. Their journal is archived at the end of each year so that children can look back and see their progress over time. An important aspect in developing these skills is supporting learners with feedback as they try to become better at reflecting on their learning. The teacher is able to comment in this area and sometimes the child will nominate peers to comment as well. To further strengthen the goals mentioned above and the home/school partnership which is so important in your child's development as a learner, we welcome your comments on your children's Learning Journals. You do not need to wait to receive their final report to do this. You can post a comment at any time as many of you have already. Simply log in to Knowledge Net using your Caregiver login, click on "Your Children" and select a child and Knowledge Net, select Learning Journal and click on Comment to leave a comment for your child. Click "Post" to save the comment. 


