

Compulsory School Uniform



At Cornwall Park District School we have a compulsory school uniform which is to be worn correctly to promote pride in our school. Our uniform provides several options for students and aims to be smart, practical and comfortable. Both summer and winter uniform items are available and these may be worn at any time of the year.

Hats

In line with the school shade policy, hats must be worn to and from school and at all times when outside during Terms 1 and 4. The school hats are designed with a broad brim for maximum face, neck and ear protection from the sun. Should your child be found not wearing their hat during morning tea time and lunch time, they will be asked to sit under the shade cover outside Room 22 (*under the school staffroom*).

Accessories

Footwear, socks and hair wear can be purchased from the School Uniform Centre or from other retailers as they are not style specific. However, these must comply with uniform rules (see overleaf).

Please ensure that all uniform items are clearly named with both first name and surname.

Second hand uniform sales are held once or twice a term. Dates for these are advertised in the school newsletter. Items are available for sale at other times by appointment only, please email admin@cornwallpark.school.nz for further details. If you have uniform items that are surplus to your requirements, these can be donated to the school office. Please put items in a plastic bag labelled 'PTA Uniform Sales'.

Compulsory School Uniform Rules

1. The correct school uniform must be worn to and from school, during school hours, when attending school events and trips, and when representing the school.

The school vests and skivvies are being phased out, however, these items may still be worn if you have them.

2. **Hats**

Strictly **NO HAT - NO PLAY – Term 1 and Term 4**

Children not wearing their hat during morning tea time and lunch-time will have to sit under the shade cover outside Room 22.

Navy CPDS Logo Bucket Hat, or Navy CPDS Logo Broad Brim – we encourage toggle tie or elastic cords to be removed for safety. No other colours or styles are acceptable

3. **Footwear**

Shoes must be worn to and from school.

*From the **beginning of 2016** all shoes will be **BLACK ONLY** these can be **sandals** (that fasten around the heel for support), **shoes**, **running shoes (lace up, buckle or Velcro fasteners)**.*

Sports Shoes

Sport shoes for PE or representative sport may be any colour.

All shoes
MUST be
BLACK and
comply with
these rules.

Class teachers ask children to remove their shoes during class time, whereas all care is taken to support children's choices during breaks, if a parent would like their child to wear their shoes during morning tea time and lunch time it is the parent's responsibility to enforce this.

FOR SAFETY REASONS - STRICTLY NO JANDALS, CROCS, OR SLIP ON SHOES ARE TO BE WORN.

4. **PE/Sports Uniform**

There is a sports uniform for senior students in Years 5 and 6 which must be worn for their sports and PE sessions including representative sports events. Year 4 students can also wear the sports uniform if they choose to. The sports uniform can also be worn for lunch time sports and other activities, but the formal school uniform must be worn to and from school and for all special occasions.

5. **Accessories**

Socks Black, white or navy

Tights Navy only

Hair Wear Hair ties - black, brown or navy. Headbands and scrunchies – black or navy
Hair clips - black, brown or navy.

Bike Pants Navy only (optional item, practical for under school dress)

Jewellery Watches and studs (sleepers are discouraged for safety reasons)

For extra warmth on cold winter days, T-shirts, singlets or thermals may be worn under the correct school uniform **PROVIDED THEY ARE NOT VISIBLE.**

Uniform Combinations

There are a number of school uniform items that can be worn together. Winter and summer uniforms items can be worn at any time of the year with the exception of the following combinations:

- A skivvy, track pants and/or bootlegs cannot be worn with the school dress (tights may be worn as an alternative option).
- Bootlegs cannot be worn with culottes.
