ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS FOR YEAR 7,

2011 : KING'S SCHOOL

Kings School write to draw your attention to the Endeavour Scholarship Programme which was launched by the Governor-General of New Zealand in October 2001 and is now in its ninth year.

The programme is open to Maori and Pasifika boys who are currently in Year 6, at the present schools, for Year 7, 2011.

It provides opportunities for four boys each year to receive an education at King's School for their Year 7 and Year 8 year. The boys spend their intermediate years at King's School and then re-assessed to see whether they qualify to move on to Kings' College for their secondary education. Their education at King's College is also paid by this scholarship should they be successful.

This is a financial scholarship which includes tuition fees, uniform allowance and other costs. The level of parental contribution is independently assessed and based on the current financial position of the parents.
